Alpacaschal

Size 1: about 77 inches long + 8 inches wide – to be

seen at the pictures

Size 2: about 77 inches long + 8,6 inches wide

Measured after washing and laid flat

Yarn: bunte wolle Alpaca 120 - 100% Alpaca (131

yards/3.53 ounces)

393 yards for size 1 - 524 yards for size 2

Needle: US 9 (5,5mm)

Abbreviations:

S = Selvedge Stitch: knit in every row

k = knit, p = purl


R = row, ST = stitch

Gauge: 20St and 26R in pattern = 4 inches

Adjust needle sizes to obtain the tension.



Pattern



Row 1:

S, *k3, p1* - repeat from * to * - ending with k3, S

Row 2:

S, k1, p1, *k3, p1* - repeat from * to * - ending with k1, S

You can easily make it wider by adding a multiple of 4 stitches.

Instructions


Cast on 41 (size 1) / 49 stitches (size 2)

R1 (right side) : S, 9x / 11x (k3, p1) , k3, S

R2 (wrong side): S, k1, p1, 9x / 11x (k3, p1), k1, S

Repeat these two rows until you reach your desired length.

Bind off loosely in pattern. Weave in yarn ends.



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
